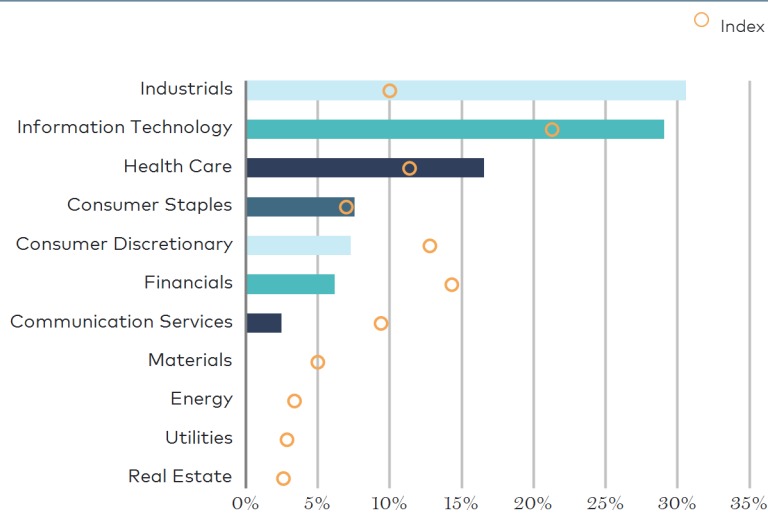

An R-squared of 1.0 would mean that the fund's movements are completely correlated with the movements of its benchmark. **Active Share** measures the difference between portfolio holdings and the benchmark. **Standard Deviation** measures the degree to which a fund's performance has varied from its average performance over a particular time period. The greater the standard deviation, the greater a fund's volatility (risk). **Upside Capture** explains how well a fund performs in time periods where the benchmark's returns are greater than zero. **Downside Capture** explains how well a fund performs in time periods where the benchmark's returns are less than zero.
